

# Bachelor of Science in Nursing

## Requirements (127 units)

Total units required for graduation: 180

## Admission Requirements

1. Application must be submitted by April 1 for Fall term and July 1 for Winter term;
2. Completion of the ATI-TEAS pre-admission examination, with a score of at least 70, by admission application deadline;
3. A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.5 overall;
4. A grade of at least C (2.0) in each prerequisite course;
5. Completion of at least half of the science and at least half of the non-science prerequisite support courses listed below is a minimum to be considered for admission, with a cumulative GPA in the completed prerequisite courses of at least 3.0.

6. Attendance at a Department of Nursing Information session.

Additional supplemental consideration will be given to a second language competence and local service area residency.

Admitted students will be permitted to register for and attend first-term nursing courses if and only if they have completed all prerequisite support courses required for admission and meet the following requirements;

- At least a 3.5 GPA overall;
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 in all prerequisite support courses;
- A grade of at least C (2.0) in each prerequisite course.
